N-1005P	Piper PA-23	Ditched in sea off Cape San Martin, Calif., 11-13-55.
N-19919	DC-3	American Flyers A/L Corp. Major damage at Fort Smith, Ark, 1:35 PM C.S.T. 11-9-55.
N-50549	C-46	Modern Air Transport. Minor damage at Roswell, New Mexico 4:30 AM M.S.T. 8 Nov 1955 due to forced landing.
N-88852	DC-4	Peninsular Air Transport. Crashed and destroyed in back yard of house at 12010 Des Moines Way, Seattle, Washington at midnight 17 Nov 1955. 27 killed, 46 injured.
N-75415	DC-4	Seaboard & Western, extensive damage at Gander 22 Nov 1955.
N-162H	Waco UPF-7	Demolished in a field as a result of a fire at Oconomowoc, Wisconsin, on 21 Nov 1955.
N-172A	Martin 2-0-2	Alleghany Air Lines. Substantial damage 14 Nov 1955 at Wilmington, Delaware.
N-991B	Bell 47-G	Destroyed in crash at 3900 Block, Lamont Street, Corpus Christi, 36 Oct 1955.
N-3541C	Cessna 170	Struck power lines while crossing Stockton Channel, Calif, west of pier 9, 15 Nov 1955. Crashed and sank.
N-487A	Martin 4-0-4	Eastern Air Lines. Both engines torn out at Huntington, West Virginia, 15 Jan 1956.
N-1846M	C-46	Riddle. Substantial damage at Stuart, Florida, 24 Jan 1956. Landing gear collapsed.
N-37501	DC-6	United Air Lines. Nosed over at Denver, Colorado, 6:05 AM MST on 15 Jan 1956. Slight damage.
N-58847	Grumman G-44	Kodiak Airways. Destroyed at Hook Point, Chignik Bay, Alaska, at 11 AM on 16 Jan 1956.
N-2749K	Luscombe 8E	Destroyed at Shoal Lake, Ontario, 11 Sept 1955 after crashing through trees.
N-33366	Lockheed 18	Destroyed near Cambridge, Ohio, 29 Dec 1955.
N-59373	Noorduyn Norseman	Wien Alaska. Destroyed by fire at Point Barrow, Alaska, on 31 Jan 1956.
N-72749	Cessna 140	Destroyed near Raymondville, Texas, 3 Jan 1956.
N-90898	DC-6	National A.L. Damaged at N.Y. International 6 Feb 1956.
N-88790	DC-3	Central Air Lines. Damaged at Fort Smith, Ark, 12-28-55.
N-7404	Viscount	Capital Air Lines. Damaged at Midway Airport 21 Feb 1956.
N-445A	Martin 4-0-4	Eastern Air Lines. Damaged at Owensboro, Kentucky, 2-17-56.
N-5159A	Cessna 170	Mid air collision with Piper N-7506H over Helena, Montana 5 Feb 1956. Both aircraft destroyed.
N-3145D	Cessna 180	Crashed in snowstorm 7 miles NW of Fargo, North Dakota, on 3 March 1956. Destroyed.
N-3115B	Cessna 170	Crashed 15 miles SE of Idaho Falls, 11 March 1956. Dest.
N-118A	Constellation	Eastern Air Lines. Substantial damage, New Orleans, La., 13 March 1956.
N-86509	Constellation	T.W.A. Slight damage at Denver, Colorado, 11 March 1956.
