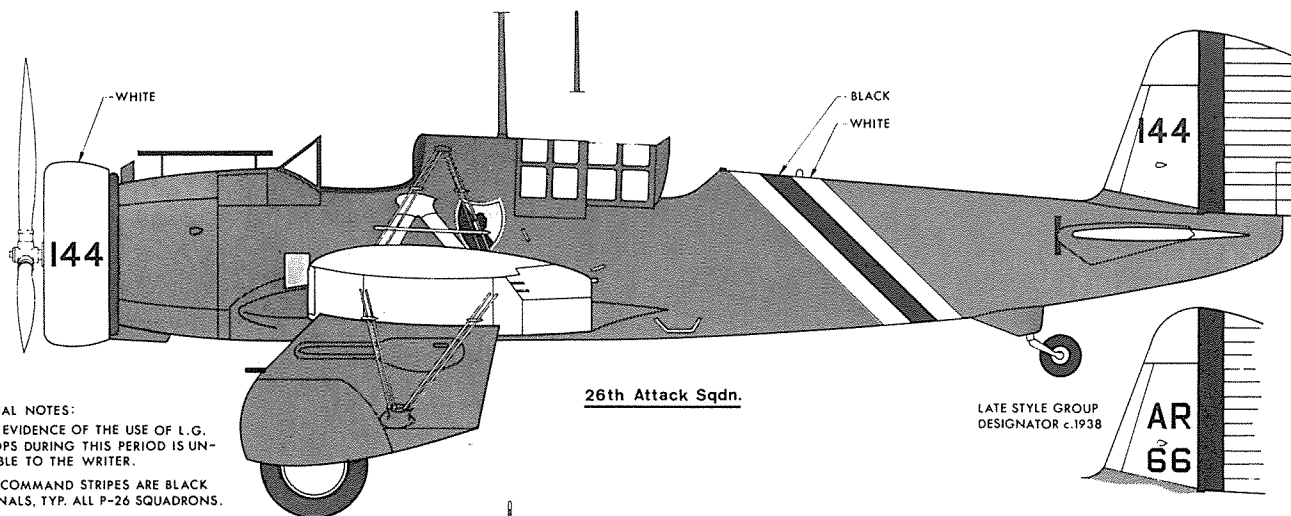


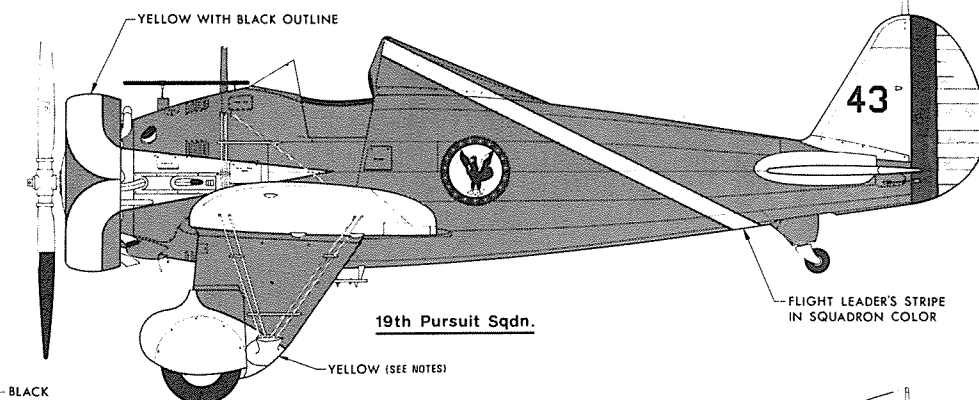
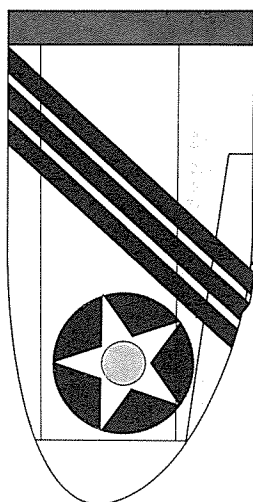

- P-26 ENGINE NOSE FAIRINGS ALSO PAINTED IN SQUADRON COLORS.

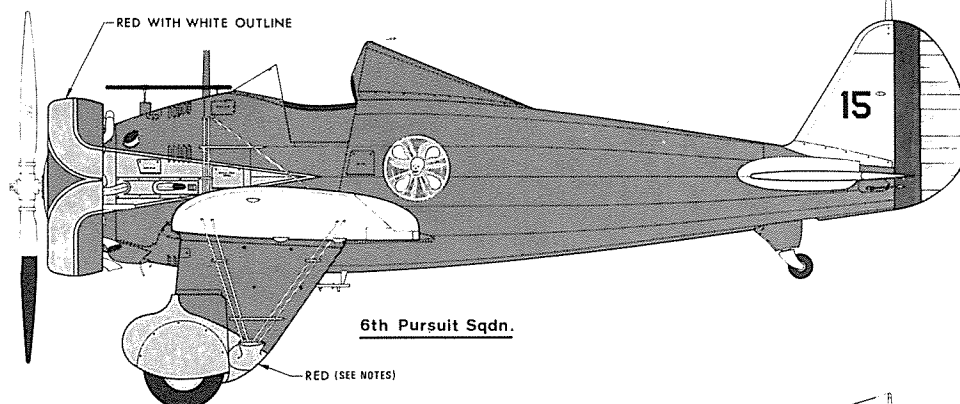

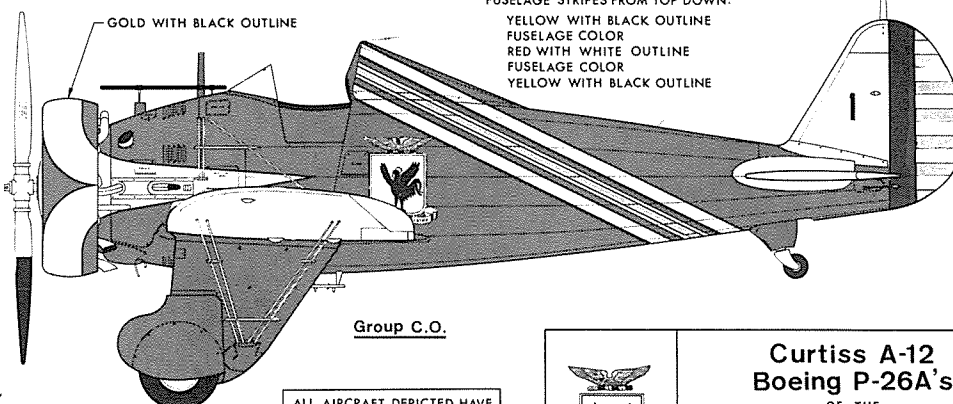
